## HOW IT WORKS

Three Card Poker is a fun and easy to learn game. You can win more than your original wager depending on how good your hand is.

The game starts with the player placing an Ante and/ or Pair Plus wager. After the wager has been placed you will be dealt three cards face down. Once you received your cards you will then decide to place a Play wager (equal to the Ante wager) or fold.

If the dealer has a hand of Jack-high or less, the Play wager is returned to the player. The Ante wager will be paid 1:1. If the dealer has a hand of Queen-high or better, both the Play and Ante wager are paid 1:1 on all winning hands.

| Pair Plus | Payouts |
| :---: | :---: |
| Straight Flush | 40 to 1 |
| Three-of-a-kind | 30 to 1 |
| Straight | 6 to 1 |
| Flush | 4 to 1 |
| Pair | 1 to 1 |


| Ante Bonus | Payouts |
| :---: | :---: |
| Straight Flush | 5 to 1 |
| Three-of-a-kind | 4 to 1 |
| Straight | 1 to 1 |

## OPTIONAL 6 CARD BONUS WAGER

Player shall win if the three cards dealt to the player and the three cards dealt to the dealer during that round of play can be used to form one of the following five-card poker hands:

| 6 Card Bonus | Payouts |
| :---: | :---: |
| Royal Flush | 1,000 to 1 |
| Straight Flush | 200 to 1 |
| Four-of-a-Kind | 50 to 1 |
| Full House | 25 to 1 |
| Flush | 15 to 1 |
| Straight | 10 to 1 |
| Three-of-a-kind | 5 to 1 |
